### Curriculum

**Literacy** – Phonics – Letters & Sounds phase 2, sequencing stories, name writing, writing labels and early reading skills.

**Communication & Language** – Wellcomm activities, expressing views and opinions, listening to others.

**Physical Development** – Pencil control, personal care and hygiene, moving in a variety of ways and spacial awareness.

**Personal, Social, and Emotional Development** – New relationships, rules and expectations, emotions and feelings.

**Maths** – Number recognition, matching numeral to quantity, shape, ordering numbers and size and pattern.

**Understanding the World** – Me, my body, my family, health, growth and senses. Exploring technology. British values and diversity.

**Expressive Arts and Design** – Model building, painting, exploring music, singing and construction.

In addition to planned lessons the children will have the opportunity to extend their learning during 'Child Initiated Learning'.
