BITESIZE BREAKFAST CLUB Terms & Conditions

1. Breakfast Club is £3.50 per session. This needs to be paid two weeks in advance, via Gateway.
2. Children must be escorted into the Breakfast Club by the parent/carer for registration.
3. Only children whose parents have completed and returned the registration form will be able to attend.
4. There is a £2.50 registration fee. This need to be paid via Gateway (except for children who already attend After School Club).
5. All fees are to be paid two weeks in advance via Gateway.
6. No-one will enter the Breakfast Club before 7:30 am.
7. No children are allowed to leave the Breakfast Club before 8:45 am.
8. There will be no refund for non-attendance due to the child being absent for any reason including sickness, weather conditions or school closures as these are beyond the control of the Breakfast Club.
9. Children are expected to respond favourably to the requests of the staff at all times.
10. Children are expected to behave responsibly and to respect each other as well as the staff.
11. Children are expected to play with the toys in an appropriate manner.
12. Children are required to tidy the toys away at the end of the Breakfast Club.
13. The Breakfast Club reserves the right to terminate membership if the rules stated above are not adhered to.
