Writing Task 1:

Watch an age appropriate film that you enjoy. Write a review of the film. Your review must focus on genre and how the film shows the features in its genre. You may want to discuss the setting or types of character the writer/producer has decided to include and how effective these are.

Reading Task:

Choose a character from the book you are reading. Create a character profile for that character. Include facts about the character (age, name) as well as personality traits and what you can work out about the character from reading about them in the text. Use evidence (quotes) from the text to support your ideas about your chosen character. Think carefully about how you set out your character profile on your page.

Writing Task 2

Watch an age appropriate film that you enjoy. Chose a 10-15 minute section of the story. This may be the opening or any interesting/ exciting section of the film. Turn this section into a written story. Remember this will not just be speech. You must include description, a range of sentence types and lengths.

Topic:

Create an air-raid shelter at home (indoors or outdoors) and include all the things you would need in your shelter. Take a picture of yourself in your shelter and write a short explanation as to why you decided to take some of the items you did, into our shelter.

Science:

Run on the spot for 30seconds. Take your pulse (for one minute) and record your results. Rest for another minute (two minutes in total). Now run on the spot for one minute. Repeat the above instructions.

Repeat the running for two minutes and three minutes. Plot your results into a bar graph.
