Reading Task:

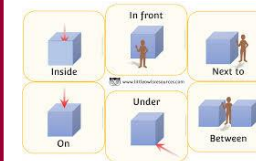
Can you go on a logo hunt around your house? Look in books, on toys and on food packages. Do you know what the logos say?



Maths:

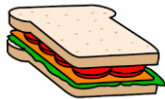
Find your favourite toy. Can you put the toy **on** a chair? **Under** a chair? **Next to** a chair?

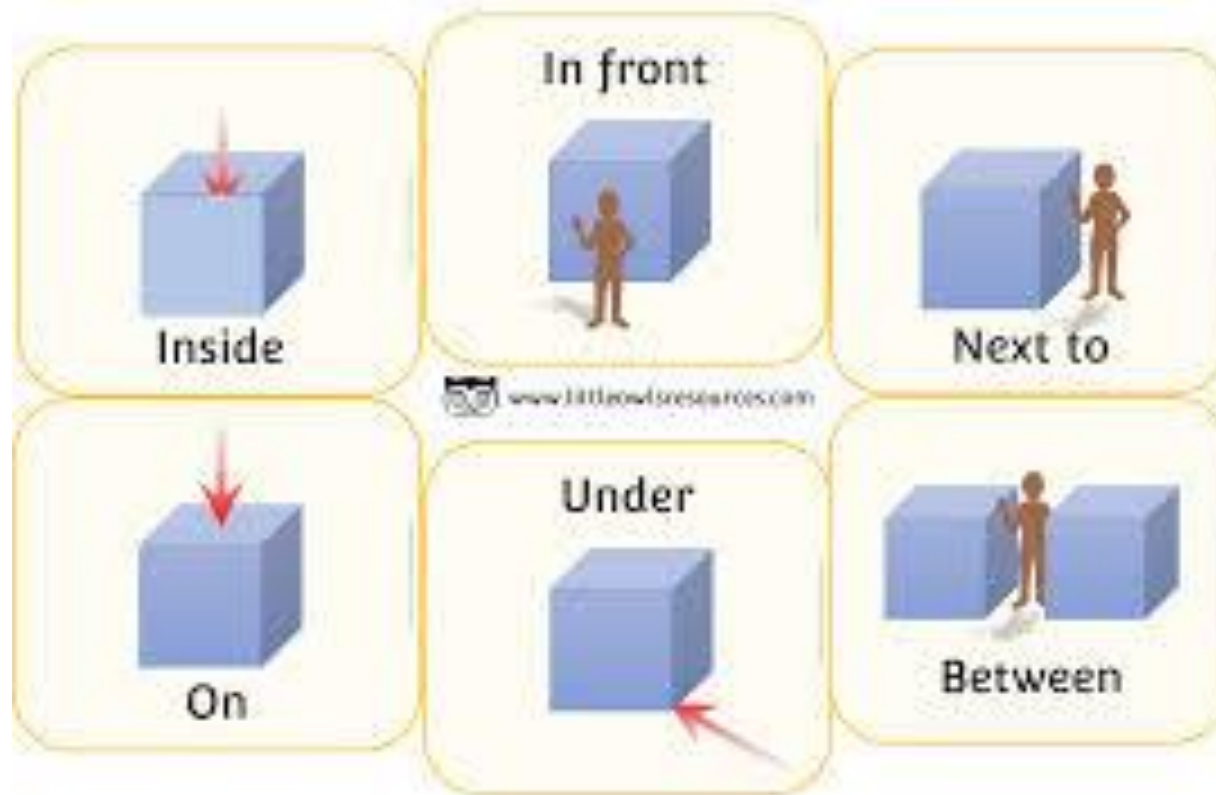
