In Maths we have been learning to:

Separate numbers into tens and units using a range of different ways e.g.:
Tens frames:

Can you write down how many tens are in each of these numbers:
12, 25, 32, 28, 19, 23, 38, 35.

In English we have been learning to:

Write recipes, instructions and ingredient lists for making porridge. As part of our Goldilocks story we have been learning how to write recipes for porridge.

Can you write your own recipe at home using those 'bossy words' we talked about e.g. put, pour, mix, blend, stir, cook.



Our topic this half term is:

'Once upon a time'. This week we have been looking at a range of old and new buildings such as castles and famous landmarks. We have discussed what these look like and created our own timelines.

In PSHE we have been discussing what it looks like to be a kind friend. Can you think of any more ways to be kind to each other?
