In Maths we have been learning to:

Ordering numbers, reading number names and solving number problems. We have been using lots of skills and number language to solve the problems in groups and pairs.

In English we have been learning to:

Write letters. Following on from our Goldilocks story we decided to have a go at writing a letter to the three bears. We looked at how letters are written, which language to use e.g. dear, from etc.

We also have been describing Goldilocks' feelings using words such as frustrated, disappointed, lonely and shocked. Can you remember any more?
