In Maths we have been focusing on:

Decimals: We have been looking at decimal numbers. The key is to understand the language used. They learned how to estimate on a number line, how to write and regroup a decimal number. This will help for next week when we look at calculating decimals.

In English we have been learning to:

We have been looking at the play scripts. We read and analysed a play called 'The Big Hairy Toe'. It was about an old woman terrified of a box she had taken. We are using the plot to create our own play with characters.

In our creative lessons we have been learning about shelter for our WOW day.

We learned about shelters created and examined which ones were stronger. We will continue to look at advanced shelters that are created by architects. We will see what makes buildings fit for purpose. Modern buildings have detailed plans compared to the early shelters created people. This will help them understand that they must plan for the WOW day activity.
