In Maths we have been learning to:

Us addition to solve money problems. We have had such a fun week using money and learning how to count out the coins correctly and ensuring we can recognise the value of them. We played lots of role play games pretending to be a customer or a shop keeper, trying to count out the correct coins.

In English we have been learning to:

Describe characters out of our new story 'Rapunzel' The children have really enjoyed listening to the story 'Rapunzel' and learning to sequence the story by creating their own story map. The children have also been using adjectives in their writing and trying to use the connective 'and'. E.g. The Prince has a red and shiny coat.
