In Maths we have been focussing on:

In maths we are moving away from fractions and coming up on measurement. Students will be looking at how to properly calculate the perimeter, area, and volume of different objects. First starting with perimeter with hands on activities to get excited for maths.

Topic and WoW day.

We will be planning our Wow day this week to ensure everyone has enough time to plan for it.

The topic this term is Vikings, Anglo-Saxons and British Colonialism. Revolving around boats and how they were used.
