In Maths, we have been :

This week we have been revising areas of weakness, which were flagged up in the recent, mock SAT tests.

These included aspects of:

Measures and time

Geometry – translations and coordinates and place value using and applying.

In Science, we have been:

Completing the final session of Sex Education.

The children have been very mature in their approach to this potentially difficult unit of work and deserve praise for their attitude throughout the lessons.

In English, we have been learning to:

Write a non-chronological report / explanatory text for a made up creature, which would appear in the Spiderwick Field Guide. They have written as if they are appealing to an adult audience and have included: precise word choices, a range of clause structures and layout features such as bullet points and sub headings.

This week's homework is:

Maths: Complete Arithmetic paper.

English: 10-minute comprehension challenge. This should only take the children 10 minutes to complete. If they required extra time, then change pen colour so we can see which were completed after the time.

Encourage your child to turn on their performance voice when reading text; this is linked to our reading fluency project.

Spelling: Test your child on a range of spelling using the spelling rule sheet provided.
