In Maths we have been focussing on:

Long division: We have been looking at a new method for long division.

We have used a number of techniques to help us.

See if you can challenge us to a long division question!

In Science, we have been looking at:

Teeth! The children have been looking at different types of teeth and how they are different depending on the diet of an animal. The children have had fun exploring different teeth and understanding the importance of keeping our teeth healthy.

In English, we have been learning to:

Improving our descriptive writing and working on our nouns and pronouns.

In the next couple of weeks we are going to be creating our own chapter for Charlie and the Chocolate factory. The children have been creating their own characters and scenes and will be starting to make up their own plot to add to the story.

This week's homework is:

Next week we will be looking at time. Try a number of things with your child over the weekend:

- See if you can challenge your child – if I started running at 10.30 and I run for an hour and a half what time would it be when I finished?
- Fastest runner – who was the fastest? How long did it take? What was the difference of the fastest and slowest person?
