## In our adult led sessions we have been:

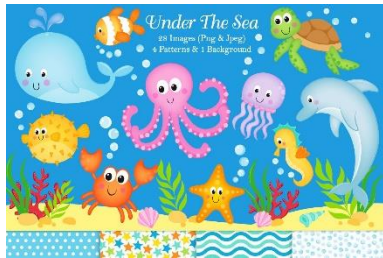
- Dancing and singing to Sticky Kids: Superman
