Maths

Children worked on place value and negative numbers. Numbers up to millions were written as figures and words and the value of digits was explored. This was also extended to decimal numbers up to three places. When looking at negative numbers, the children have practiced counting through zero in whole numbers and decimals and finding the difference between numbers.

English

Children explored more of our class reading book, 'The world in Johnny's back garden.' We have acted parts of the story out, made notes on what has happened and predicted what might happen. The children looked in detail at the main characters and wrote descriptions about their physical appearance as well as their personality. The children have also been learning about commas and apostrophes.

Topic
