In Maths we have been learning to:

Use number lines to complete addition and subtraction sums. We have been trying hard to remember which way to count on the numberline and recording the sums correctly.

In our CLIC maths we have been starting to count in 5's and 10's. Can you remember a pattern?

Our topic this half term is:

'Places to play' this week we have been looking at materials, such as plastic, wood, glass and metal. We have been thinking about what objects are made of and thinking about play equipment.

In English we have been learning to:
