Maths

This week in maths we have moved from place value to multiplying and dividing whole numbers and decimal numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. We have applied these skills to measure and currency questions to determine the children's understanding. Additionally, we have looked at and drilled on multiplication to ensure we have a good understanding of all elements of the four operations, which are subtraction, addition, division and multiplication.

English

Children explored more of our class reading book, 'The world in Johnny's back garden.' The children further looked in detail at the main characters, particularly at Maisie a major character in the book. We looked at how her contribution has moved the story on. We also wrote a full description about her physical appearance as well as her personality. The children have also been learning about frontal adverbials and where they fit into a sentence.
