In Maths we have been learning to:

Recall and record number bonds to 10. We have been using the resource 'numicon' to record number bonds to 10 in our maths books.

In our CLIC lessons we have been looking at how to double numbers and practising counting in 10s, and 5s, saying them in a range of different voices.

Our topic this half term is:

'Places to play' this week we have been on a reading walk around the school. We have been looking for and reading signs around the school which help us.

In our circle time we looked at pictures and made our own signs which we would see at different places to play.

In English we have been learning to:
