In Maths we have been learning to:

Show one more and one less pictorially. We have been using 'tens frames' to show one more and one less using counters. We have also used bead strings and unifix to help us see what one more and one less looks like.

In English we have been learning to:

All about poems. Firstly we looked at 'The owl and the pussycat' which we learnt using our own actions we created. We have looked and compared stories to poems noticing some similarities and differences. We then explored rhyme, writing words and sentences which rhyme. On Friday we performed our Owl and the pussycat performance to some children in reception and Miss Flanagan.
