In English this week:

We have been exploring different poems. We learnt about the different features of poems and then acted them out. We wrote a repeated poem and tried to use a range of adjectives to describe the animals.

In Maths this week:

We have been looking at number lines. We started the week by exploring benchmarks and how to work out the middle number. We then estimated where a number would go onto the number line using the benchmarks.
