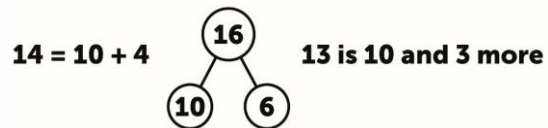

In Maths we have been learning to:

Make numbers to 20 using a range of manipulatives. We have looked at numicon, dienes, multilink cubes, cuisinaire rods to make a variety of models. We have also been using part models:



In English we have been learning to:

Identify main events of a story. For the next two weeks we are looking at a story called 'We're going on a leaf hunt'. We have acted out the story and identified the beginning, middle and end. We have really enjoyed this story and it links well with our topic 'seasons' where we can look at autumn in lots of detail. At the end of the week we innovated characters from the story using our imagination.



Our topic this half term is:

'Seasons'. This week we have been going out in the outside area and recording the weather each day. We looked up on the computer the temperature in Stevenage and recorded it. We also made our own seasons plates to decorate for our role play area. We have also started to practice our song for the Christmas performance called 'The Bossy King'.
