In English this week:

We have been learning about recounts. We explored the features of recounts and found out they are written in first person and past tense.

We have been learning about how we can use number facts to help us subtract numbers quickly. We then looked at how we can use these number facts and how we can make them 10 times bigger. For example if we know $8-4=4$ then $80-40=40$ is easy!
