In Maths we have been learning to:

make doubles and halves using a range of manipulatives. We have been using multilink cubes, tens frames to see how to double and half numbers.

We used lots of language such as:

'I know that double 5 is 10,

I know that half of 10 is 5,

I know that $5 + 5 = 10$

I know that $10 - 5 = 5$.'

In English we have been learning to:

Write our own story. The children worked very hard to create their own 'were going on a leaf hunt' story. We carefully planned out the beginning, middle and end of the story by creating a story map. Each day we recorded a different part of the story. We checked our stories for the correct punctuation and then read them to a friend.



Our topic this half term is:

'Seasons'. This week we have been working on building our own role play area in our classroom, so far we have created seasons plates, snowflakes and a joint collage of reindeers and snowmen.

We have also been very busy practising our new dances for our Christmas play 'The Bossy King'. Can you practice your dance moves at home?
