## Maths

This week year 6's have looked at mock SATS papers and had a go! This has been very beneficial as it clearly demonstrates where extra support maybe needed. We are particularly looking at fractions and common denominators.

Year 5 have continued looking at factors and prime numbers and gaining an understanding of why times table knowledge is so important. They have also been multiplying 2 digit by 2 digit numbers.

## English
