Writing/Reading Task:

1. Write an explanation text to explain how a game or toy works.
OR
2. Rewrite the ending to a book. Choose one that you thought had a disappointing ending.

Science Task:

1. Write a piece about a distant relative. Speak to your parents and other relatives to research this person's history. Do you share any traits with them? What features do you think you have inherited from them?
OR
2. Design and make a model of a fairground ride. You may choose to include battery power for any moving parts.

Cultural Task:

1. Visit a fairground or watch a child appropriate clip about fairground rides. Draw a diagram and write an explanation explaining how one of the rides works.
OR
2. Find out about how Christmas is celebrated in different countries around the world.

RE Task:

You are a steward of the Earth! Your job is to maintain the Earth's happy environment such as wildlife, nature and the fresh air we breathe. Write a description of what you do to maintain the Earth's happy environment. This could be collecting litter, volunteering at an animal shelter, planting plants and trees or anything else you do to keep the world a wonderful place.

Creative Project:

1. Bake a Victorian desert such as a Victorian sponge. Bring it in to share with your class.
OR
2. Write a poem about Victorian times.

Presenting Task:

1. Present your findings about your chosen pieces of home learning.
