In Maths we have been learning to:

use comparative language in the context of mass, length, height and time. We have been using language such as: shorter, heavier, lightest, smallest, taller etc.

We have been creating lots of experiments and recorded results. Do you remember who was the tallest in the class?
Who was the smallest in the class?

Our topic this half term is:

'Once upon a time'. We will be exploring lots of traditional tales this term which we are very excited about. This week we have completed a floating and sinking experiment. We made our own predictions and tested out which materials would sink and float, we then recorded our results.

In English we have been learning to:

Write a chronological report. When we returned back to school this year, somebody had been in our class. We discussed the crime scene and played 'hotseating' deciding who has been in the class. We have also discussed what a report is and read a range of them.
