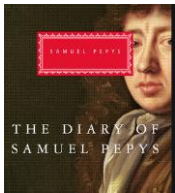

In maths this week the children have been working hard to add two numbers containing 2 digits such as $23+14=37$ We have used Base 10 to work practically and help our understanding. Next, we have moved onto equations where we need to regroup the ones into a 10. For example

$$46+15=61$$
