WEEK ENDING: 7th February 2020

In Maths we have been learning to:
Represent equal values to make the same total. We have been using cubes to represent totals e.g, when making 14 we used
10 cubes and 4 cubes
12 cubes and 2 cubes
 $10+4 = 14 = 12+2$

We then used Cuisenaire rods and bead strings to make the same totals in varied ways.

Our topic this half term is:
'Once upon a time'. This week we have created our own castle pictures using a wide range of creative objects. We thought about how to add features of the castles and who might live in them.

In English we have been learning to:
Write adjectives and looking at plural nouns. This week our new story is the Gingerbread man. We have been predicting alternative plots for the end eg who could have eaten the gingerbread man? We also used exciting adjectives to describe the gingerbread man and then thought about adding 's' onto certain words. We walked around the school and recorded all the groups of objects that we could see.
