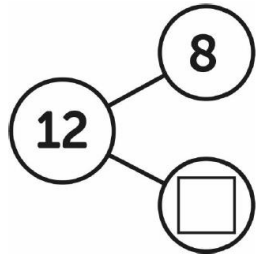

In Maths we have been learning to:

Identify the part and whole of a number. We have used Cuisenaire rods to help us identify which part is missing of a number. We then used cherry models to complete calculations- see below:



Our topic this half term is:

'Once upon a time'. This week we have wrote out a menu for our banquet on Friday. We have hought about what kings and queens would eat at their banquet and how to create it. We have also been preparing for the WOW day by learning the story 'the gingerbread man' with lots of 'talk for writing' actions.

In English we have been learning to:

Write postcards to the gingerbreads uncle- blueberry muffin. We played a hot seating game where we portrayed the gingerbread man character and retold the stoy from his perspective.
