In Maths we have been learning to:

We have been completing word problems. We have thought about the language of problem solving and how to complete the whole and parts. We have been looking at problems such as:

Lyla has 14 cards she gives 6 away to Izzy. How many does she have left?
Paige has 15 books, her friend Thomas gives her 6 more. How many does she have altogether?
Which are the parts? Which is the whole?

Our topic this half term is:

'Once upon a time'. We have been talking a lot about wolves which features lots in our story. This week we looked at facts about wolves and recorded these facts in groups. We also create our own maps for Little red riding hood, thinking about the correct directional language to use. In our RE lessons we looked at what is lent and thought about items that we would give up for 40 days.

In English we have been learning to:

Orally rehearse and record questions and sentences about a familiar story. This week we have been looking at the story 'Little Red Riding hood'. We have been sequencing the story and thinking about excellent questions to ask the wolf.

The children thought of:
Why did you want to eat the grandma?
Where do you live?
Why are you so unkind and mean?
