With your child you can 'dip into' any of the activities on the sheet. Your child can present their learning in any way they would like and bring in their pieces of work any time during the half term to share with their class.

Get investigating: can you find out some animal facts that your friends might not know using the computer or books

Get creating: can you create an animal enclosure? what will you use to make it? How will you join the materials? How will you decorate them? Can you plan how you will make it first?

Get mathematical: can you order some animals in order of size from smallest to biggest

Get reading: can you read an animal story with your grown up that you have not read before. Maybe you could do a comic strip to tell your friends about the story.



Get visiting: Can you visit some animals? Do your relatives have animals? We would love to see some pictures of you with the animals that you have visited

Get outdoors: go for a walk. What animals do you see on your walk? Can you record how many you saw?
