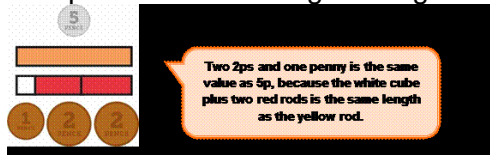


**WEEK ENDING: 13th March 2020**

## In Maths we have been learning to:

compare values. We started by comparing the difference between two numbers using tens frames and the 'hexagon of difference'.

Later in the week we have been looking at the value of coins. We have thought about what the value of 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p and 20p really means and how to show representations using rods eg:



## In English we have been learning to:

Describe new characters and innovate. We have created lots of writing about 'Little Red Riding Hood'. To end our unit, we decided to create our own story using new characters eg 'Little Red Riding Hood and the unicorn'. We created our plan to ensure our story would have a clear beginning, middle and end. On Friday we wrote our stories using the new language and phrases we have learnt.



## Our topic this half term is:

'Once upon a time'. We have been creating beautiful baskets by using the skill of weaving. We thought about what Little Red Riding Hood would use her basket for and which materials to use.

In our RE lessons we looked at moral stories including 'The tortoise and the Hare'. And discussed what the meaning is.
