Home Learning

We sent home an ideas list of suggested home learning activities for you and your child to dip into.

Thank you if you have sent some work in for us to see! It would be lovely to receive a few more emails with some pictures or text about what your child has been up to at home and we will print it out and display it in our classroom.

In Maths this week:

We have been focusing on representing numbers. We have been finding lots of different ways of representing the same number using numicon, multi-link cubes, drawing dots onto a tens frame and writing the digit as well. Reception have had a number of day to represent. They have learnt about numbers 1-5.

In English this week:

Year one have been reading the book 'Stanley's Stick'. On Monday the children went outside and collected their own stick, just like Stanley! Their focus this week has been writing using full sentence structure and we have been writing sentences about Stanley's magical stick.

Reception have had an Autumn focus.

They collected their own sticks and leaves and followed instructions to make a natural object mobile and then labelled Autumn objects focusing on hearing and writing the initial sounds.

Our topic this half term is:

'Places to play.' This week we have been focusing on Autumn and exploring the different changes. We went out in small groups to collect natural objects and then made our own Autumnal collage. We have also spent time setting up our outside area with an autumn theme, working Mrs Riley and Miss Townsend to do this.
