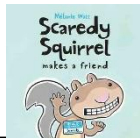

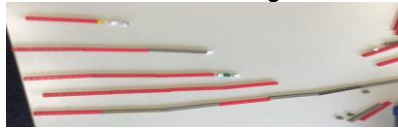
In English this week:
