In Maths, we:

Commenced work on fractions. Children were first reminded of the most common fractions and how these could be modelled. We looked at fraction word problems and used a range of strategies to solve them. Some children worked on number bonds. Children were asked to prove and explain their answers, which encouraged their reasoning skills. Well done to all!

In English, we:

Continued reading the story - Mini Rabbit Not Lost. Throughout the week, we have worked to improve our sentence construction, using adverbs, prepositions, interesting sentence starters, noun phrases, dramatic adjectives and dialogue. Children then rewrote the Mini Rabbit story using their own words and edited their work. Well done children!
