Maths

In maths this week year 6 have been looking at fractions, place value revision, percentages and potential SATS questions. Next week is Mock SATS week.

Year 5 have been looking at mental maths calculations for all four operation as well as looking for different strategies to solve mathematical problems for fraction questions.
