We are Mathematicians

Can you identify shapes around you? Whilst you are out and about with your adults look to see the different shapes around you. Can you find a circle, triangle, rectangle, square or star? How many shapes can you identify whilst you are out? Perhaps you could take some pictures of the different objects and shapes that you find. Which shape is your favourite? Can you explain why it is your favourite shape?

We are Historians

Spend time looking at your family photo album or pictures of you and your family. Talk about what is happening in the picture. Who is in the picture and how are they important to you? Why was the picture taken? When was the picture taken?

We are Scientists

With your adults you can make indoor fireworks:
Ingredients:
Tbsp Water ,1 Tbsp Baking soda 2 Tbsp Vinegar a splash of food colouring.

- Place a bowl or cup on a pan or tray (or you'll get potion all over the place!)
- Fill the bowl with 2 tablespoons of water and stir in a tablespoon of baking soda until it dissolves.
- Measure 2 tablespoons of vinegar into a separate cup.
- Pour the vinegar, all at once into the water/baking soda mixture and watch your potion bubble up!
