Writing Task:

Option1: You are a Roman soldier arriving on the shore of Britain. Write a diary or letter home describing the conditions on the battlefield.

Option 2: You are a Roman senator. Describe the assassination of Julius Caesar.

Reading Task:

Ensure that you are reading a minimum of 4 times a week and logging it in your reading record.

Cultural Task:

Within RE we have been investigating celebrations and festivals. Chose any religious festival and create a factsheet for this festival.

Such as:

Date of the festival; significance of the festival; customs and special dress. Illustrate with symbols and pictures associated with your chosen festival.

Science Task:

Romans named their Gods after the planets. Design, sketch and describe your own newly discovered planet.

Describe the appearance, terrain, atmosphere and size in comparison to Earth. (You may wish to use the name of a Roman god for your planet).

Creative Project:

The Colosseum was a symbol of Roman might and their main hub for entertainment.

Create your own model colosseum using cardboard, papier mache or any materials.

Be as creative as you can with your materials!

History Task:

Research which country Julius Caesar attempted to invade, but failed.

Describe the key dates and reasons for the failure.
