Writing Task:

Option 1: You are one of Alexander the Great's hoplites (Soldiers). Write a diary or letter home detailing your experiences in battle.

Option 2: Alexander the Great died while marching through Babylon. Many believe he was poisoned or died of a fever. Describe the events leading to his death.

Reading Task:

Ensure that you are reading a minimum of 4 times a week and logging it in your reading record.

Cultural Task:

Such as:

Date of the festival; significance of the festival; customs and special dress. Illustrate with symbols and pictures associated with your chosen festival.

Science Task:

Create a pinhole camera at home. There are many different instructions available online and can be made using household items such as: sharp pencil, empty shoe box with a lid, scissors, ruler, wax paper, tape, blanket.

Creative Project:

You are a Greek god sitting on top of Mount Olympus. Zeus has asked you to create a new god. What would they be the god of?

Create a profile and a model of your God using household objects.

Be as creative as possible.

History Task:
