We are communicators:

Think of some rules that you follow at home. Talk to your grown-ups about why they are important!

Example: One rule we have at home is that only Mummy/Daddy can touch the oven. This is because it is hot and you might get burnt.

We make relationships:

Find out who is in your family and how everyone is related. Is your Nanny Mummy's mum or Daddy's mum? Create a family tree with your grown-up.

We are authors and readers:

Share your favourite book with someone in your family.

Can you retell the story using the illustrations?

We are physical learners:

Practise throwing and catching with someone in your family. You could use a ball, a stuffed toy, a crumpled up piece of paper etc.

Can you throw it at a target? Can you score points?

We are engineers, musicians or artists:

Can you build your own classroom using junk modelling? Who will be the teacher?

Can you create your own instrument using objects at home? You could use wooden spoons and bang them on a pan, or make a maraca!

Can you draw a portrait of a ruler from school or home?

We are curious about our world:

Can you look at pictures of houses/classrooms around the world? Are they the same as your house or different? What are they like? Would you like to live there?

There are some lovely ideas of places to live in the book 'You Choose.'
