Dear Parents / Carers

Re: Ruby and Diamond Class Trip to Verulamium Museum, St Albans

We are excited to announce that we have arranged for Ruby and Diamond Class to visit the Verulamium Museum in St Albans on **Monday the 28th March**. The children will get to see at first-hand a wide range of artefacts from the Roman era, as well as viewing museum displays of people during Roman times. Children will discover how artefacts would have looked, and have been used, during the Roman times. They will also have the opportunity of being able to view a real hypocaust along with the ruins of a Roman theatre.

The cost of the trip is £15.00 per child, which includes the museum, Roman theatre entry and the coach. The children should arrive at school at normal time and will return by 3.15pm, in time for the end of school day. We would therefore request a voluntary contribution of £15 in order for the trip to go ahead.

There is also a shop at the museum where the children can purchase items. Please note that the maximum amount children can bring into school is £5.

Children should wear their usual school uniform and bring a packed lunch and a drink in a disposable bag (no fizzy drinks, cans, glass bottles or chocolate), please. Children that are entitled to free school meals can have a pack lunch supplied by the kitchen. Please let the school office know if you would like one.

In order for the trip to go ahead, and to secure the booking, we would ask that a deposit of £7.50 is paid by Wednesday 9th March and the final payment of £7.50 by the 21st March 2022. Payment and consent are available on the School Gateway from today.

Please be aware that if there are not enough voluntary contributions, the trip will not be able to go ahead as planned.
