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We are Authors

Rosie Revere makes gadgets out of junk, but they don't always go right straight away. Choose a gadget you could make and write (or ask your adult to scribe) a story where you are the main character. What do you make? What goes wrong? How do you fix it?

We are Phonics Experts

You will be getting an envelope of sounds to practise at home. Practise every day until you know them really quickly! Can you make your own sound cards out of recycled cardboard or cereal boxes? Can you make words with these sounds? Also, remember to read your book every day!

We are Scientists

Choose a week to make a weather chart. Start on Monday and draw a symbol or write a sentence to show what the weather is like in the morning and when you get home after school. How did the weather change over the week? Can you feedback the findings in a weather report?

We are Geography Experts

Make a poster to show ways we can look after our planet, to help with our topic about carbon footprint.

Books at your local library or at home could help you to research!

We are Mathematicians

Following on from sharing, find an amount of up to 20 objects at home that are small, for example, pasta, coins, toys or teddies. Imagine you are sharing the objects between 2 friends. Would there be any left over or could you share equally? What if there were 3 friends that you were giving the objects to?
