

Curriculum Overview Year 2: Spring

All children should be reading aloud to an adult every day.

General reminders: Please remember that home learning needs to be returned on a Tuesday. New home learning will be handed out on a Friday. Reading records and books should be brought to school every day. Reading books will be changed every Friday. PE is on Tuesday and Friday. On P.E days, please can all children come to school in their PE kit. Year 2 will be sharing their learning in a class assembly later this term.

Maths

We are currently learning about money. How to recognise coins, count coins and make the same amount in different ways.

They will then be learning about statistics, including block graphs, pictograms, tables and tally charts.

They will be learning about multiplication and division, including learning about the 2, 5 and 10 times table.

They will be learning about time, including reading time, ordering and comparing time.

English

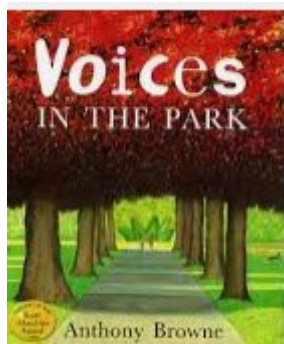
Year 2 are currently reading and writing a wide variety of poems based on the poetry book 'Poems Aloud' by Joseph Coelho.

They will be continuing to develop their use of conjunctions, accurate sentence punctuation and the use of more details in their sentences. They will be focusing on reading with greater fluency and answering more questions based on a text.

Geography

In our topic we are learning about coastlines. In this topic the children will learn about the physical and human features of coastal regions across the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the coastal town of Whitby, in Yorkshire.

Science

Year 2 will be learning about materials, their properties and uses. The children will be learning about the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes. They begin to explore how materials can be changed.

Art

This topic is called 'Flower Head.' The children will learn about the visual elements of flowers, including shape, texture, colour, pattern and form. They also explore various artistic methods, including drawing and printmaking.

Music

We will be learning the song 'I Wanna Play In A Band' by Joanna Manna. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, children will listen and appraise classic Rock songs.

RE

The children will be learning about Losar, a Buddhist festival, and how it is celebrated around the world. They will also be learning about Anand Karaj, a Sikh festival, and how it is celebrated.

PSHE

Out topics are 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Healthy me'. We will be learning about success and their strengths as well as how to work with others. They will also be learning about healthy eating and keeping themselves safe.

Computing

We will be learning about how to keep themselves safe on computers and devices. They will also be learning to look for patterns and to plan and create simple algorithms.

DT

This topic is called Beach Hut and we will learning about making and strengthening structures, including different ways of joining materials.
