

Curriculum Overview Year 4: Spring

All children should be reading aloud to an adult every day.

General reminders:

Please remember that home learning needs to be returned on a Tuesday. New home learning will be handed out on a Friday. Reading records and books should be brought to school every day. PE is on Tuesday and Thursday. The children are to come to school in their PE kit. Year 4 will be sharing their learning in a class assembly later this term.

Maths

During the Spring term, we will be working on multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100 and applying this when converting between units of measurement including time. The children will use their knowledge of measures to solve problems.

Moving on the children will learn about interpreting and presenting data, properties of shape including perimeter and symmetry. We will then move on to decimals and money.

English

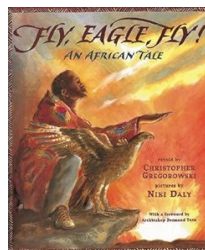
In English we will be focusing on composing our own poetry, taking inspiration from the current poet Laureate Joseph Coelho before moving on to Fly Eagle Fly where we will be including descriptive detail to make writing more vivid.

The children will also be planning and writing their own narratives based on The Iron Man.

Geography

This term's topic is called 'Misty Mountain, Winding River.' This project teaches children about the characteristics and features of rivers and mountain ranges around the world, including a detailed exploration of the ecosystems and processes that shape them and the land around them.

Science

We will be learning about states of matter. We will look at solids, liquids and gases and their characteristic properties. The children will observe how materials change state as they are heated and cooled.

They will also learn about grouping living things, known as classification, studying the animal and plant king-

Art

We will be learning about vistas, discovering the techniques that artists use when composing landscape images, such as colour and atmosphere.

History

Within our topic we will be looking at how environments have changed our time as well as how the uses of rivers and mountain areas has changed over time.

Music

We will continue to build on our music knowledge of this year so far. This term our learning will be focused around one song: Stop! - a rap/song about bullying.

RE

We will be learning about the Sikh celebration of Vaisakhi, the five Ks and the Khalsa. We will also focus on Holy Week and Easter, learning about Palm Sunday and the last supper.

PSHE

In PHSE, we will look at the Jigsaw scheme of work, Dreams and Goals. We will investigate jobs and careers as well as helping others to achieve their goals.

Computing

We will continue our learning around keeping safe online. We will be re-researching landscape artist to support our Art as well as learning about rivers and mountains of the UK and the world. We will continue to use TTRockstars to improve our times tables.

DT

We will be learning about the significant designer William Morris. The children will explore block printing.

MFL

We will be learning to present ourselves through greetings and introductions, saying our names and asking questions.
