

Curriculum Overview Year 5: Summer

All children should be reading aloud to an adult every day.

General reminders:

Year 5 PE days this term are Monday and Thursday.

Please remember that home learning needs to be returned on a Tuesday. New home learning will be handed out on a Friday. Reading records and books should be brought to school every day.

Maths

During the Summer term, children will continue their work on angles, including how to estimate and compare acute, obtuse and reflex angles. Children will measure angles accurately with a protractor before estimating angles in degrees and check by measuring. We will also be identifying unknown angles.

We will also cover statistics and Roman Numerals.

English

In English we will be focusing reading for meaning, drawing inferences, and justifying these inferences with evidence. We will use the book Hermelin to analyse and explain the impact of the author's use of language.

We will also be looking at play scripts and balanced arguments, linked back to our topic of Groundbreaking Greeks.

Geography

Linked to our History topic of Groundbreaking Greeks, pupils will interpret a range of sources of geographical information, including maps, diagrams, globes and aerial photographs

Science

This term we will be looking at Properties and Changes of materials.

They will learn about mixtures and how they can be separated using sieving, filtration and evaporation.
They study reversible and irreversible changes, and use common indicators to identify irreversible changes.

Art

In art we will explore paper crafts, papermaking and collage techniques, including paper, fabric, mixed media and photo collage. We will create a final piece of small-scale, mixed media collage.

History

Groundbreaking Greeks will teach pupils about developments and changes over six periods of ancient Greek history, focusing on the city state of Athens in the Classical age, and exploring the lasting legacy of ancient Greece.

Music

We will focus on Motown in this unit. We will explore in detail 'Dancing In The Street' by Martha And The Vandellas.

<u>RE</u>

We will learn about the origins of Passover, which is one of the most important Jewish festivals.

It commemorates the time Moses led the Israelite slaves to freedom over 3000 years ago.

PSHE

In PHSE, we will look at the Jigsaw scheme of work, Relationships as well as Changing Me. We will look at self esteem, the online community, screen time as well as changes to your body during puberty.

Computing

In Computing we will be applying programming skills to create sounds and melodies leading to a battle of the bands performance.

We will also continue to learn about potential online dangers and safety.

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We will look at how architectural style and technology has developed over time and then use this knowledge to design a building with specific features.

MFL (Spanish)

Pupils will learn to present both orally and in written form about where they live and which rooms they have and do not have in their homes in Spanish.
