

Curriculum Overview Year 3: Summer

All children should be reading aloud to an adult every day.

General reminders:

Maths

During the Summer term, children will work on multiplication and division, time as well as regular revision of addition and subtraction.

The children will be continuing to complete TT Rockstars timed times table revision. This is designed to support them as they travel towards Year 4 and the times table test.

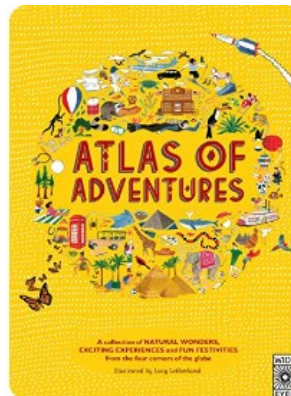
English

In English we will be exploring a number of fantastic books including: The Atlas of Adventure— where we will be discovering the world; a project about Pirates, Reading a book called Yokki and the Parno Gry which looks at Romani culture and looking at the Bear and the Piano.

Geography

We will be revising the areas of Geography that we have been learning about so far and applying it to our learning in English.

Science

The children will be learning about plant nutrition and reproduction. We will be learning about how plants get nutrition from soil and water; how more plants are made and the conditions that they need to grow in.

We will then be looking at light and shadow. The children will be learning how shadows are formed, how they change and how they move.

Art

The children will learn shading and sketching techniques along with using colour to create images of flowers.

They will then be drawing mosaic patterns and learning about tessellations.

History

Within our topic we will be coming out of pre-history and stepping into the Roman period.

We will be learning about who they were; what they did; how they conquered ; how long they stayed and why they left.

Music

This half term we will be looking at "Bringing us together,". This is a song based on the style of "Disco" so we will be comparing it with similar songs and learning to play it.

RE

We will be focusing on the Christian festival of lent and why it is important to Christians. Will also be learning how they celebrate it, what it means to them and what it represents.

PSHE

In PHSE, we will look at the Jigsaw scheme of work, Dreams and Goals. We will investigate jobs and careers as well as helping others to achieve their goals.

Computing

We will use the computing lessons to research History and Geography topics. We will also be using TT Rockstars to build our times table knowledge as well as using the laptops to make power points about Art topics.

DT

Our DT project is called 'Making it move.' This project is linked to 'Rocks, Relics and Rumbles'.
