

## Curriculum Overview Year 3: Summer

All children should be reading aloud to an adult every day.

### General reminders:

Reading records and books should be brought to school every day. It is important that children are reading at home regularly. Children should be regularly using Times Tables Rock Stars to develop their timetables. Reading books will be changed on a Friday. PE is now on a Tuesday and Thursday.

### Maths.

In Maths, we will be looking at adding and subtracting fractions. We will also be looking Capacity, focusing on reading and comparing units of measure. We will then move on to look at Money, adding and subtracting amounts and finding chance, After that, we will be focusing on time where we will be learning to tell the time to the nearest minute. We will then be exploring shape, including angles. Finally, we will look at drawing and interpreting pictograms and bar charts.

### English

The children will be reading various books to develop and improve their understanding and sentence structures. For those who are ready, they will be improving their ability to add detail, description and more adventurous vocabulary to their work.

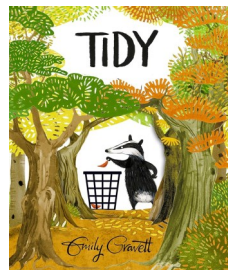
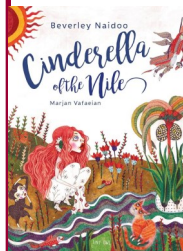
They will also be learning about parts of a sentence and how to be accurate with punctuation.

### History & Geography

The children will be learning about the Egyptians including who the Egyptians were, why the pyramids were built and what the Egyptians had in common with other civilisations at the time.

In geography, the children will be learning about their local area.

### Science

We will be continuing to explore light and shadows.

We will be learning about the life cycle of plants, by identifying their features, and understanding what germination and seed dispersal is. We will then be looking at biodiversity and sustainability and why it is so important.

### Art

The children will be learning about how art can be used to tell stories. They will be learning how to use a sketch book to make visual notes, how artists show characters in their illustrations and how to create simple sculptures.

### Music

The children will be learning how music can be made with three notes using rhythm and be listening to a variety of songs so that they can begin to hear the different chords and components in the music.

### RE

In RE this term we will be looking at how Muslims show respect towards Allah and how stories from the Quran help guide them. We will then be looking at different faiths comparing and celebrating their similarities and differences. Including places of worship and how they worship.

### PSHE

The children will be learning about healthy relationships, how to solve problems and about how we change as we grow.

### Computing

The children will be learning about desktop publishing and how to complete actions in programs.

### DT

In DT, the children will be learning about and making different mechanism.

### MFL

The children will be completing their learning explaining what they know how to do and be learning about fruits and vegetables.
