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Dear Parents and Carers,

Adventurers

Your child may come home today talking about a new intervention called **Adventurers and having a 'passport'**.

Adventurers is an exciting small group intervention led by **Mrs Chase** and **Miss Twomey**, with support from **Miss Fry**. Only 8 children across KS2 have been selected and your child is one of them. The programme will provide opportunities for the children to participate in an afternoon of practical, adapted learning activities that meet their needs. These sessions are designed to help children develop strategies for engaging successfully in school, managing their emotions and feelings, building resilience, and developing confidence in themselves as learners. Before going to these session at 1.15pm, the children will need to make sure that all their morning work has been completed and they will earn stamps in their passports for their efforts in the morning. If they still need to do some of their work, they will be required to catch this up before joining in with the activities in Adventurers.

Through a range of fun, hands-on activities, we hope to support children in developing skills that will help them both in the classroom and beyond.

We are very excited to be launching Adventurers and look forward to seeing the positive impact it has on the children involved.
